TERMS OF OFFICE

ORDINANCE NO. 1402.01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING STAGGERED ONE-YEAR AND TWO-YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE FOR CITY COUNCIL AND PROVIDING FOR THE SELECTION OF TERMS BY COUNCIL

- WHEREAS, the City of San Elizario, Texas (“City”) is a newly-created governmental entity that was incorporated pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas as a Type A, General-Law Municipality following an election held on November 5, 2013; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas, Texas Local Government Code Chapter 22, the Mayor and City Council of San Elizario (“Alderspersons”) were duly elected following an election held May 10, 2014, and subsequently sworn into office; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas, Texas Local Government Code Chapter 22, the Mayor and Alderspersons are elected to two year terms; and
- WHEREAS, a governing body of a municipality is authorized by Texas Local Government Code Chapter 22 to determine by ordinance the number and the manner of deciding which alderspersons elected at the initial election serve for one year and which serve for two years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO:

- Section 1: At the municipal election, held May 10, 2014, Leticia Miranda, David Cantu, Miguel Najera, Jr., Rebecca Martinez-Juarez and George Almanzar were duly elected as Alderspersons for the City.
- Section 2: 3 (number) alderspersons will serve a one-year term, and 2 (number) alderspersons will serve for two years.
- Section 3: The selection of the one-year and two-year terms for each aldersperson place is to be decided by drawing lots.

Section 4: On August 12th, 2014, at a meeting at which a quorum was present and for which due notice was given, all Alderpersons participated in the drawing of lots for terms of office.

Section 5: The results of the drawing held August 12th, 2014 were as follows:

Leticia Miranda	Place 1	<u>one</u> year term
David Cantu	Place 2	<u>one</u> year term
Miguel Najera, Jr.	Place 3	<u>one</u> year term
Rebecca Martinez-Juarez	Place 4	<u>two</u> year term
George Almanzar	Place 5	<u>two</u> year term

Section 6: These aldermen places shall be held initially for the terms indicated in accord with these results.

Section 7: Thereafter, an election for alderperson places shall be held and all alderpersons shall serve for a term of two years as provided by law.

Section 8: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Council.
