RESOLUTION NO. 1901R.07

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO DESIGNATING THE EL PASO TIMES AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER FOR THE CITY

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code Section 52.004(a) requires a city to contract each year with a public newspaper to be the city's official newspaper; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Elizario, Texas finds that the El Paso Times is a paper of general circulation within the City of San Elizario, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the El Paso Times is a paper that meets all of the criteria legally required of an officially designated newspaper for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of San Elizario, Texas, that:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.
- Section 2. The City Council hereby designates the El Paso Times as the official newspaper for the City of San Elizario for one year.
- Section 3. To fulfill statutory requirements for notice and as provided in Local Government Code Section 52.004(b), the City Council hereby authorizes that

each ordinance, notice, or other matter required by law or ordinance to be published in the El Paso Times.


Section 4. All resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

Section 5. Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Resolution be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Resolution.


Section 6. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.
