**RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS
OF THE 2020 CITY GENERAL ELECTION**

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Elizario ordered a general election to be held in said City on May 9, 2020, for the purpose of electing the following named City officials for two-year terms: Mayor and Aldersons Places 4 and 5; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Elizario amended the general election order to allow the election to be held on November 3, 2020 in accordance with the lawful order of the Governor of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made returns of the results thereof, and said returns have been delivered to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Elizario finds that the approval of this Resolution is action taken during a meeting held at the City's current usual place as it is in the manner as posted on the notice and agenda of the meeting which is allowed by the lawful order of the Governor of the State of Texas.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO, TEXAS:

1. The foregoing Recitals are hereby adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.

2. That the City Council officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered, that proper notice of said election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election, that said election was duly held, that due returns of the results of said election had been duly made and delivered, that the election returns have been properly made out and duly certified by the officers of said election in the voting precinct of the City, and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with the law.

3. That the City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election for the following officers, by the resident, qualified electors of said City, who voted at the election:



5. That on file in the City Clerk's Office and made a part hereof by reference are copies of the cumulative reports and the electronic precinct tabulations of the votes cast at the 2020 City General Election for each candidate.
6. That this Resolution is adopted subject to the right of any candidate to contest such election in any way provided by law.
7. That this Resolution was acted upon in accordance with the law by the presiding officer and the City Council and was deemed by said City Council, that upon passage of the Resolution, it shall take effect immediately.
8. This Resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the City Council, and the City Clerk shall record the results so adopted in the separate book kept in her office for such purpose.
9. All resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.
10. Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Resolution be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Resolution.


