Resolution 2010R.04

Whereas, the County of El Paso, Texas ("County") has studied the need for expanded transportation services within the rural areas of the County;

Whereas, the County has secured federal funding in order to begin the work necessary to create a regional multimodal transportation system in the urban areas of the County;

Whereas, in order to undertake the work, the County has elected to create a non-profit corporation as provided for in the Local Government Corporation Act, Texas Transportation Code Section 431.01, et seq., the Texas Nonprofit Corporation Law, Chapter 22, Business Organizations Code, Section 22.001, et seq. in order allow municipalities within the rural areas of the County to participate in the process of planning for, creating, operating and governing a regional multimodal transportation system;

Whereas, on December 7, 2020, the El Paso County, Texas Commissioner's Court approved the creation of the El Paso Area Transportation Service, LGC ("EPATS");

Whereas, the County has invited the City of San Elizario to participate in EPATS and the Mayor and City Council has determined that it will be of benefit to the residents of the City of San Elizario to do so;

Now therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of San Elizario as follows:

- 1. That the City Council approves the City of San Elizario's participation in EPATS;
- 2. That the City Council approves the Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, and Code of Ethics or EPATS set forth by the County and agrees to comply with the terms of said documents:

3. That the City appoints Maya Sanchez, City Administrator, to serve as the City's representative and Director of EPATS until such time as her replacement is appointed by the San Elizario City Council.
