RESOLUTION NO. 1505R.07A

- WHEREAS, the City of San Elizario (hereinafter "the City") is in the process of receiving a donation of 1.7 acres of park land from the County of El Paso which is dedicated and known to all as "Tedd F. Richardson Park"; and
- WHEREAS, the City has resolved to make application to the Texas Department of Parks and Wildlife (hereinafter, "the Department") for grant assistance to develop and improve the aforementioned park for the benefit of all local residents; and
- WHEREAS, in order to participate in the Department's Local Parks grant program, the City must formally commit financial resources to help meet the required fifty percent (50%) match of grant funds provided by the Department; and
- WHEREAS, in order to operate and maintain the aforementioned park in perpetuity, the City must also budget an annual sum to cover the reasonable costs of park upkeep,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The City will budget every year in perpetuity, or during the useful life of the park, a reasonable sum allocated from its General Fund to cover the cost of normal maintenance and upkeep of said park, which sum in the first year of operation by the City shall be not less than 5, 000, 00 DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$5,000,00); and
- 2. The City's budgetary commitment described above will be contingent upon an award of grant funding by the Department under its Local Parks program., and if the City's proposed Park Improvement Project is not awarded grant funding by the Department then this commitment by the City shall remain null and void.

PASSED AND ADOPTED this, the 22 day of September, 2015, by a vote of 5 (ayes) to 8 (nays) to 6 (abstentions) of the City Council of San Elizario, Texas.
