RESOLUTION NO. 1704R.12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN AWARD APPLICATION WITH THE RIO GRANDE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR A REGIONAL SOLID WASTE AWARDS PROGRAM AWARD.

WHEREAS, the Rio Grande Council of Governments (RGCOG) is directed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to administer solid waste award funds for implementation of the adopted regional solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Elizario ("City") is qualified to apply for award funds under the RGCOG managed program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to apply and finds that applying for RGCOG funding will serve the public and is in the public's best interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of San Elizario, Texas, that:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.
- Section 2. The City Council hereby approves the submission of an application to the Regional Solid Waste Awards Program for award funding.
- Section 3. The City Council hereby agrees that if the project is funded, the City will comply with the award requirements of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the State of Texas.
- Section 4. The City Council hereby agrees that award funds and any award-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the award.


Section 5. The City Council hereby agrees that activities will comply with and will support the regional and local solid waste management plans adopted for the geographical area in which the activities are performed.

Section 6. The City Council hereby authorizes Alderman David Cantu to submit the application and to act on behalf of the City in all matters related to the award application and any subsequent award and award project that may result.

Section 7. This Resolution shall be effective upon its passage and approval.
