5. Discussion and Action: Regarding filling the vacancy for Alderperson Place 1 resulting from the resignation of Leticia Miranda received on November 28, 2022, and directing staff to release a call for potential candidates to fulfill the term, which expires in May 2023. **Mayor Reyes**
