RESOLUTION NO. 1610R.03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO, TEXAS, OPPOSING ANY LEGISLATION THAT INCREASES THE MAXIMUM TRANSPORT HAUL WEIGHTS OVER ROADWAYS IN THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO AND STATEWIDE, FINDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF:

- WHEREAS, legislation may be proposed in the 2017 Texas Legislative Session to allow trucks to increase their maximum haul weight from 80,000 pounds to 97,000 pounds along certain roadways within the City of San Elizario and State of Texas; and
- WHEREAS, the City of San Elizario is concerned about the safety of Texas citizens as a result of increasing maximum transport haul weights; and
- WHEREAS, the City of San Elizario is concerned about the negative effects to the transportation infrastructure from any additional maximum transport haul weights;
- WHEREAS, the City of San Elizario is concerned that negative impacts in other Texas municipalities will require the State to divert funding that would otherwise be invested in the City's transportation infrastructure projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of San Elizario, Texas, that:

Section I. The City of San Elizario opposes any legislation that would increase the maximum transport haul weights for trucks on roads and bridges in the City of San Elizario and Texas.

Section 2. The City Council officially finds, determines, recites and declares that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of this meeting of the City Council is posted at a place convenient to the public at the City Hall of the City for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter thereof has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The

City Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its passage and approval.
