A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO, TEXAS CREATING THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO HISTORICAL LANDMARK COMMISSION

RECITALS

WHEREAS,

development of the El Paso Mission Trail Historic District within the City of San Elizario ("City") is overseen by the County Commissioners of the County of El Paso ("County Commissioners") pursuant to Texas Local Government Code 231.172; and

WHEREAS,

the City Council ("City Council") of the City desires to assume this oversight and has requested that enforcement be assigned to the City; and

WHEREAS.

the County Commissioners issued an interim order assigning to the City the oversight, administration and enforcement of the El Paso Mission Trail Historical Area Zoning Regulations ("Regulations") via its *Order Relating to the Appointment of Administrative Bodies of the City of San Elizario, Texas* ("Order") dated August 29, 2016, attached hereto and incorporated fully herein; and

WHEREAS,

in accordance with the Order, the City Council desires to establish the City of San Elizario Historical Landmark Commission ("Commission") which shall serve as the County Mission Trail Historical Landmark Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Elizario:

SECTION I. FINDINGS OF FACT

The foregoing recitals are adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.

SECTION II. CREATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF LANDMARK COMMISSION

- I. The City Council of the City of San Elizario hereby creates and establishes the City of San Elizario Historical Landmark Commission.
- 2. The Commission shall consist of five members and shall perform the duties contained in the Regulations and shall serve in the interim until further notice.
- 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to appoint the Commission members in accordance with the Regulations.

SECTION III. REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY

REPEALER: All resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

SEVERABILITY: Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Resolution be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Resolution.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and publication.
