ORDINANCE NO. 1803.01 AMENDMENT No. 2 TO ORDINANCE 1703.01.01

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENT No. 2 TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS TO REVENUE AND EXPENSES RELATING TO CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING: FINDINGS OF FACT, REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

- WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1703.01.01, the City of San Elizario ("City") adopted its Annual Budget for Fiscal Year ("FY") 2017-2018; and
- WHEREAS, since adoption of the budget, the City needs to make revisions to the budget relating to the holding of a trash and tire amnesty day on July 14, 2018; and
- WHEREAS, in the best interest of prudent budgeting, the City Council desires to amend the City's Annual Budget to reflect such transfer in FY 2017-2018; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council has authorization pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 102.010 to amend its budget; and
- WHEREAS, upon passage, the City Clerk shall provide a copy of this Ordinance to the El Paso County Clerk as required by Section 102.009(d), Texas Local Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of San Elizario:

ARTICLE I. FINDINGS OF FACT

The foregoing recitals are adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.

ARTICLE II. BUDGET AMENDMENT

1) The City Council hereby amends and approves the following amendment to the municipal budget for fiscal year 2017-2018, to add the following line items:

Revenue: Decrease Transportation Study, Capital Project \$4,645.00 Expense: Trash and Tire amnesty day related costs \$4,645.00.

ARTICLE III. REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY

REPEALER: All ordinances, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

SEVERABILITY: Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Ordinance.

ARTICLE IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
