RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE RIO GRANDE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR A REGIONAL SOLID WASTE GRANTS PROGRAM GRANT; AUTHORIZING DAVID CANTU TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE RIO GRANDE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY AND THE STATE OF TEXAS.
