RESOLUTION NO. 1901R.02

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO ESTABLISHING THE LOCATION FOR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS AND DESIGNATION OF CITY HALL AS THE PLACE OF POSTING NOTICES.

RECITALS

- WHEREAS, since incorporation, the City has acquired buildings and the use of buildings for city purposes; and
- WHEREAS, the City has recently opened a new facility at 12004 Socorro Road and will utilize this facility in part for the City Council Chambers and the courtroom for the San Elizario Municipal Court; and
- WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the City Council to formally act to designate the standard location for the holding of its meetings and for the posting of meeting notices under the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code; and
- WHEREAS, this Resolution is appropriate pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.034, which authorizes the city to hold real property within the city limits; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City Council finds that it is necessary and proper for the good government and order of the City to adopt this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of San Elizario, Texas, that:

1. The foregoing Recitals are hereby adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.

- 2. The City Council of the City of San Elizario hereby designates the City facility located at 12004 Socorro Road in the City of San Elizario as the regular location for the holding of regular and special meetings of the City Council.
- 3. The City Council of the City of San Elizario hereby continues the designation of the City facility located at 12710 Church Street in the City of San Elizario as City Hall and the location where the City posts notice of each meeting of the City Council on the bulletin board established for such purpose in accordance with Section 551.050(b) of the Texas Government Code (Open Meetings Act).
- 4. All resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, save for the City of San Elizario Subdivision Ordinance referenced herein, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.
- 5. Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Resolution be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Resolution.
- 6. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.
