RESOLUTION NO. 1901R.05.03

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO AND THE COUNTY OF EL PASO TO PROVIDE ANIMAL WELFARE SERVICES.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Elizario ("City") entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the County of El Paso for the provision of animal welfare services in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Elizario ("City") now desires to terminate that agreement as the City is entering into an Interlocal Agreement with the Tigua Facility Services, Inc. for the provision of these services; and

WHEREAS, Section VII of the Agreement with the County provides that it may be terminated by either party without cause by written notice received via certified mail at least forty-five days in advance of the effective date of termination.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of San Elizario, Texas, that:

1. The foregoing Recitals are hereby adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.
2. The City Council of the City of San Elizario hereby terminates the Interlocal Agreement with the County of El Paso for the provision of animal welfare services in the City without cause in the manner authorized by Section VII of the Agreement.

3. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to send the notice of termination to County to be effective in accordance with the provisions of the agreement.
4. All resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.
5. Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Resolution be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Resolution.
6. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.


