**RESOLUTION NO. 1903R.06**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A COMMUNITY HEART & SOUL® GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ORTON FAMILY FOUNDATION AND THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO TO PROVIDE FUNDING A TRAINING AND MENTORING COACH, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE RETENTION OF THE SERVICES OF THE COACH.**

**WHEREAS,** the San Elizario Community Heart & Soul volunteer organization ("Heart & Soul") is an ongoing collaborative partnership between the Orton Family Foundation ("Foundation") and the City of San Elizario ("City") since June 2017; and

**WHEREAS,** Heart & Soul has worked tirelessly in our community encouraging the values of family friendliness, education, connection to nature, history, art and culture, agricultural, a strong local economy, prosperity, health, a sense of community, community involvement and volunteerism, livability, infrastructure and city services, unique physical and historical assets, inclusive and responsive government; and

**WHEREAS,** the Foundation is willing to grant the City the amount of \$20,000 to provide funding to compensate a training and mentoring coach, and the City is willing to accept the funding, retain the services of a coach and embark on the four phases of Heart & Soul over the next two years; and


**WHEREAS,** the City finds that the acceptance of the grant and the retention of the services of a training and mentoring coach is appropriate and entry into the Grant Agreement and in the best interest of the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO, TEXAS, that**

1. The foregoing recitals are adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.
2. The City Council hereby accepts the grant and approves the Grant Agreement between the Orton Family Foundation and the City of San Elizario and authorizes the Mayor to sign the Agreement.
3. The Mayor is authorized to negotiate and sign an independent services agreement with Rebeca (Becki) Cantú Helmstetler, as approved as to form by the City Attorney, in a total amount of direct compensation not to exceed \$20,000.00 (the amount of the grant).


