# **ORDINANCE NO. 2003.09**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CERTIFIED APPRAISAL ROLL SUBMITTED BY THE EL PASO COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT FOR THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO FOR TAX YEAR 2020.

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Tax Appraisal District has prepared, certified and submitted the appraisal roll of taxable property for the City of San Elizario ("City") for Tax Year 2020; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Tax Code Section 26.09, the certified appraisal roll shall be used by the City Council of the City in preparation of its FY 2020-2021 budget and calculation of its corresponding tax rate.

#### ARTICLE I. FINDINGS OF FACT

#### ARTICLE II. APPROVAL OF CERTIFIED APPRAISAL TAX ROLL

The City Council of the City hereby approves the certified appraisal roll submitted by the El Paso County Appraisal District for Tax Year 2020 for the City of San Elizario.

### ARTICLE III. REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY

REPEALER: All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

SEVERABILITY: Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Ordinance.

## ARTICLE IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
