A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO TO CREATE AN ADOPT A PARK/RIGHT-OF-WAY PROGRAM FOR VOLUNTEER SERVICES AT CITY PARKS, DEMONSTRATION GARDENS AND ON THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

RECITALS

- WHEREAS, volunteerism is a service and provides benefits not only to the community but also to the volunteer; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Elizario ("City") has created other programs to authorize and encourage volunteer services within the community and now desires to provide volunteer opportunities for organizations and individuals in conjunction with the upkeep of the City's parks, demonstration gardens and rights of way; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council finds that providing these volunteer opportunities will serve the public and be of benefit to the City and to the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of San Elizario, Texas, that:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.
- Section 2. The City Council hereby established a volunteer program as provided in Attachment A ("Project").
- Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign the Volunteer Services Agreements that are determined to be necessary and appropriate for the Project.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.
- Section 5. The City Administrator is directed to begin the implementation of the program at such time when appropriate under or at the end of the declared emergency in the

City and/or to bring the item back to City Council for any further action as she may determine to be necessary.

ADOPT A PARK/RIGHT-OF-WAY PROGRAM FOR VOLUNTEER SERVICES AT CITY PARKS, DEMONSTRATION GARDENS AND ON THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY

Program Purpose:

Participation in the Adopt a Park/Right-of-Way program of the City of San Elizario is open to any individual, group, club or organization that wants to actively contribute to the betterment of a City of San Elizario Park, one or more of the City's demonstration gardens or a portion of a right-of-way of the City.

This program is created to provide benefits to both the City and the volunteers. Participation helps to foster a sense of pride and stewardship in the community; provides opportunities for volunteer service and serves to create additional and better relationships between residents and the City.

Opportunity for volunteer services:

A Volunteer can agree to any of the following.

- Picking up litter
- Beautification efforts, including pulling weeds
- Checking the parks and areas and reporting damage and law violations to the City/Marshal's Office
- Donating site amenities or services
- Other services as approved by the City

Application and approval process:

The general process to become a volunteer will include the following, as well as any additional requirements administratively determined to be appropriate and necessary

- Fill out the application and submit to staff at City Hall.
- Application will be reviewed, and City staff will contact the applicant to clarify commitments
- City staff will prepare a Volunteer Services Agreement
- All parties sign the Agreement.
