RESOLUTION NO. 2015R.05.01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ELIZARIO TO DELEGATE TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR THE ABILITY TO PERFORM THE RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER SECTION 212.0115 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FOR THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH PLAT REQUIREMENTS.

RECITALS

- **WHEREAS**, the City Council ("City Council") of the City of San Elizario ("City") adopted Ordinance No. 1915.20, the Subdivision Ordinance of the City of San Elizario; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of San Elizario Subdivision Ordinance provides for the issuance of a certificate of plat compliance by the City Council; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in Section 212.0115(i) of the Texas Local Government Code, the City has determined that it is appropriate in the interests of efficiency and the need to meet the statutory deadlines, to delegate the ability to perform the responsibilities under Section 212.0115 to the City Administrator or his/her designee; and
- **WHEREAS**, this Resolution shall serve as the statutorily required written delegation of this authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Elizario:

ARTICLE I. FINDINGS OF FACT

The foregoing recitals are adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.

Resolution, delegation of authority, certification of plat compliance

As provided in Section 212.0115 of the Texas Local Government Code and Section 3.13.6 of the Subdivision Ordinance of the City of San Elizario, a binding decision of the City Administrator is appealable to the City Council.

ARTICLE III. REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY

REPEALER: All resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

SEVERABILITY: Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Resolution be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Resolution.

ARTICLE IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
