WHEREAS, the City of San Elizario, Texas is a Type A General-Law Municipality and as such is required to designate an official newspaper in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 52.004 at or near the beginning of each fiscal year;

- 1. devotes at least 25% of its total column lineage to general interest items;
- 2. is published at least once a week;
- 3. is entered as 2d -class postal matter in the county where published; and
- 4. has been published regularly and continuously for at least 12 months;

WHEREAS, the San Elizario City Council finds that the *El Paso Times* is a newspaper of general circulation within the City of San Elizario; and

WHEREAS, the San Elizario City Council finds that the *El Paso Times* meets of the legally required criteria to be designated the official newspaper for the City of San Elizario.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the City of San Elizario Council that:

- 1. The *El Paso Times* is designated the official newspaper for the City of San Elizario for fiscal year 2021, commencing October 1, 2021.
- 2. The City Administrator or her designee is authorized to sign a contract with the *El Paso Times* establishing the applicable rates for publication of city notices.
