## **RESOLUTION NO. 2210R.04**

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Policy Board (TPB) of the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization was established in 1973 to meet the requirement that urbanized areas with a population of 50,000 or greater must have a transportation planning board to ensure that all regional transportation studies are performed in accordance with local governments' desires and in conformance with federal and state laws, rules, and regulations;

**WHEREAS**, the TPB is comprised of 30 elected and/or appointed public officials from the local governments that have authority for project implementation. Membership in the TPB also includes local and county elected officials, State Senators, and State Representatives;

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Article III of the TPB Bylaws, the City of San Elizario is entitled to have one representative/member on the TPB who is either the Mayor or another elected official appointed by the City Council;

**WHEREAS**, the TPB Bylaws require each governmental entity provide the Executive Director of the MPO with a copy of the resolution approved by the governing body designating their representative;


**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to designate the City of San Elizario TPB representative;


That Mayor Isela Reyes is designated the as the representative of the City of San Elizario on the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Policy Board.
