**EMERGENCY ADDITION TO THE
NOTICE AND AGENDA OF SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Friday, March 20, 2020 at 12:00 PM**

This Emergency Addition is given to the Notice and Agenda for Special Meeting of the City Council of San Elizario, Texas on **Friday, March 20, 2020 at 12:00 pm at San Elizario City Council Chambers, 12004 Socorro Rd. San Elizario, Texas** at which time the following additional emergency items will be discussed and voted on, to wit:

I. Discussion and Action: Approve an Ordinance adding a second amendment to Ordinance No. 2001.03, as amended by Ordinance No. 2001.03.01, which called a general election on May 2, 2020 for the election of the positions of Mayor, Alderson Place 4 and Alderson Place 5, to postpone the election to November 3, 2020 and to revise the provisions for the conduct of the election. Action on this item is an emergency and an urgent public necessary because immediate action is required of the City to timely act to postpone this election to November 3, 2020, due to the imminent threat to public health and safety presented by the COVID-19 virus (coronavirus) in connection with holding the election on May 2, 2020, and further, this situation was reasonably unforeseeable as the Governor just issued the proclamation allowing the City to move its election on March 18, 2020.

2. Discussion and Action: Approve an Ordinance Instituting Emergency Measures Due to a Public Health Emergency in the City, and to declare that a violation of the ordinance is a misdemeanor offense with a maximum penalty of \$500. Action on this item is an emergency and an urgent public necessary because immediate action is required of the City to appropriately address the imminent threat to public health and safety presented by the COVID-19 virus (coronavirus), and further, this situation was reasonably unforeseeable due to the sudden onset of the emergency and need for restrictive measures to protect both City employees and members of the public.

Discussion and Action: Approve a Resolution instituting temporary provisions for the submission of applications for plats and other applications under the Subdivision Ordinance of the City of San Elizario, Ordinance No. 1915.20. Action on this item is an emergency and an urgent public necessary because immediate action is required of the City to appropriately address the imminent threat to public health and safety presented by the COVID-19 virus (coronavirus), and further, this situation was reasonably unforeseeable due to the sudden onset of the emergency and need for restrictive measures to protect both City employees and members of the public.
